Regular Council Meeting

May 22, 2017

The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Latta.

Attendance:

Roll call was taken showing the following in attendance: Mr. Turner, Mr. Myers, Ms. Cary, Mr. Clark, Ms Seele & Mr. Rader. Also in attendance were Fiscal Officer Laura Ewing, Solicitor Rob Feighner, Police Chief Greg Smith, Administrator Kevin Siferd and Mayor Charles Latta.

Minutes:

A motion to approve the minutes from the Regular Council meeting from May 8, 2017 was made by Myers, seconded by Turner. All council members voted "yes", the minutes were approved.

Vouchers:

A motion to approve vouchers for \$24,335.19 was made by Myers, seconded by Turner. All members voted "yes". The vouchers were approved.

Visitors : Tamara Vanatta responded to a noise complaint pointing out that the complaint was invalid since the complaint was not from an adjoining property. She stated that the animals are not making as much noise. Carl Muniz complained of junk vehicles, trash on properties and grass clippings in the street. Also requested that holes in the back of the park be repaired and a solution to parking at the park during T-ball. Tim Bechtal presented the inclusion of the Village to the purple heart proclamation. Richard Rettig asked if a mobile home can be placed on a vacant lot that is for sale. Morey Fenstermaker stated that the Hall residence grass needs cut, requested that properties on the Memorial Day parade route be mowed and that weeds on the sidewalks at Bennetts be taken care of. John Cross who is running for the 83rd seat in the Ohio Senate presented his platform.

Administrators Report:

Peterman & Assoc. are gathering more information for South Street and storm water projects. Morelock Asphalt was the lowest bidder for the street resurfacing project. The pool has been filled and filters have started. Will be scheduling an appointment soon with the health department for an inspection. Trying to make contact with the Hall property to get the yard mowed. Asphalt at the curb work will be ready to drive on by Friday. Meeting with soil conservation to discuss plans for the ditch. Pepsi removed its machine due to low sales. The gas line at the agronomy need replaced. Newsletter will go out June 1, 2017. Will send a letter to Newcomer about standing water. A rep for the emergency siren will be making a site visit.

Also discussed was an aerial map of the park to be placed at the info center. Cary motioned to approve the minutes, seconded by Seele. Invited Siferd and Smith to the next fire district meeting to discuss security. Stated that the grass needs mowed at Shady Acres four-way stop. Complained that the house across from the fire building blew grass on the road. Motioned to hold an executive session to hold a conference with the board's attorney to discuss matters which are the subject of pending or imminent court actions, seconded by Cary.
