

Village of Mc Comb

Regular Council Meeting

August 13, 2018

The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 p.m.

Attendance:

Roll call was taken showing the following in attendance: Mrs. Cary, Mrs. Seele, Mr. Myers, Mrs. Schroll, Mr. Rader, Mr. Clark were present. Also in attendance were Village Administrator Kevin Siferd, Sara Klay, Police Chief Greg Smith, and Mayor Charles Latta and Solicitor Rob Feightner, along with thirteen visitors.

Minutes:

A motion to approve the minutes from the Regular Council meeting from July 23, 2018 was made by Myers, seconded by Seele. A vote was taken, Cary "abstain", Clark "yes", Rader "yes", Schroll "yes", Seele "yes", Myers "Yes". Motion passed.

Vouchers: A motion to approve vouchers for \$89,793.40 was made by Cary, seconded by Myers, Council members Schroll, Rader, Seele, Clark, Cary and Myers voted "yes", the vouchers were approved.

Visitors: Beth Clark from ODOT Safe Route to School Coordinator spoke on the safe route to school plan. Said that we are in stage three of the process. Jim Schroll questioned limiting parking for his property on Todd Street and the plans for the water runoff from building the curb and street up and the water running into his building. He stated that the intersection is safe as is with the 4-way stop. Anika Ewing said "wider sidewalks will not make the kids not walk in the road". She asked if the state is going to do anything about the hump in the road on Todd Street. Brad Brown questioned the parking on Todd Street with changing the sidewalk. Heather Muniz said "Her mom ran over a child because of how the kids do not pay attention while walking home from school". Heather Muniz also complained about the property at 424 W South Street. Ken Agner complained about a neighbor running a generator full time. Kevin told him he would check the ordinances. Mike Barrett wanted to know why the school board did not pay for the spirit squad mural, he was informed that is a question he would need to ask that board.

Village Administrator: Sidewalks are replaced and completed will be adding dirt as needed. The Village Pool will be closing for the season on August 28 at that time we will no longer have life guards available for work. Tom Lovell will be looking in to a part that needs fixed at the pool and will be working on it over the winter. Cross walks will be painted before the start of school. Notified everyone that the reason the reservoir water is low due to no rain and Northwest Water and Sewer District is lowering it to 17 feet for repairs. The Village Trick-or-Treat is scheduled for October 31 6-7pm with a costume parade at 7:30. The Spirit Squad asked for a donation for the new mural that will be painted on Primrose Flower building. At this time council has decided to wait and add to "old business". Letters went out to home owners for yards. A temporary parking was given out to Mike Sellers for a wedding.

A motion was made by Schroll to approve the meeting minutes seconded by Cary, a vote was taken all council members voted "yes". Motion passed.

Ms. Cary : Thanked everyone for the Cookie Fest participation. Thanked Kevin for cleaning up the weeds at the park. Asked about score boards- Kevin said in a week or two they will be done.

Asked to have bathroom information at the next park meetings. Complimented on police being out and about. Thanked the cleanup crew for the Cookie Fest.

Mr. Clark : No big purchases for the rest of the year to end the year ok. Advised everyone to be careful for the rest of the year on spending.


