Regular Council Meeting

July 8, 2019

The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 p.m.

Attendance:




Roll call was taken showing the following in attendance: Schroll, Mygrant, and Myers were present. Cary, Seele and Clark were absent. Cannot excuse absence due to no quorum. Also in attendance were Mayor Charles Latta, Chief Greg Smith, Administrator Allyson Murray and Utility Clerk Wylie Haas. There was one visitor.

Minutes:

Council stated the absences of Cary, Seele and Clark were not able to be excused. Representative Tom from NWWSD was in to speak on behalf of the New Build on Oliver St. Myers asked about the possibility of other properties that may have this situation, and Tom stated he isn't sure because this is a rare instance. When NWWSD took over the lines they were not aware of which water lines were this way. The tap is not extended far enough and Myers asked if they can have them 1 foot beyond the curb and then place the responsibility on the owners. Myers also stated that Allyson told him NWWSD were giving the home owners a break on the fees. Allyson did not say this, it was corrected that the home owners paid less due to the tap already being on the line. On average the home owner would pay \$2,600 but the tap was already there so they just had to purchase the meter at \$253. The total cost for the new home owner was \$2,478 when it could have been way higher. The fees to tap into water and sewer are the responsibility of the home owner and that is stated on the NWWSD website and in the Ohio Revised Code. "No other places do it differently," Tom's response to if other villages or cities pay for new builds to have water and sewer taps.
