**ORDINANCE NO. O-2017-09  
VILLAGE OF MCCOMB, OHIO**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING O-1992-11 KNOWN AS AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS AND POSTING A BOND TO GUARANTEE THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS IN THE VILLAGE OF MCCOMB, OHIO**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of McComb, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1: REPEAL**

That Ordinance Number O-1992-11 and other Ordinances and/or parts of Ordinances in conflict or related herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed

**SECTION 2: WHEREAS**, Council desires to remove Section 2 of O-1992-11 referring to the posting of a cash bond for the construction of new sidewalks in the Village.

**WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


