AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL FROM THIS DATE ANY PAST PART-TIME OFFICER ORDINANCES, OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCOMB, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the Village of McComb has presented to the Mayor and Council a proposal to repeal any of the past ordinances for part-time officer(s).

WHEREAS, such Repeal of any Past Part-Time Police Officer Ordinances will allow the Village to start with a new and updated Ordinance in the near future and this would be of benefit to the Citizens of the Village of McComb, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of McComb, County of Hancock, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1: That there is hereby established a Repeal of ANY past Ordinances for the position of Part-time Police Officer for the Village of McComb, Ohio Police Department.

Section 2: That whereas, the Repeal of said Past Part-Time Police Officer Ordinances would be a benefit to the safety of the Citizens of the Village of McComb. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of McComb, Ohio.

Wherefore: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law, and approval by the Mayor.
