McComb Pool Rules

1. **Everyone** must sign in and pay at the window before entering pool area. Children 5 and under and adults 65 and older are admitted free of charge. When leaving pool area with the intentions of returning the same day, please obtain a stamp from the pool office.
2. Children 7 and under must be accompanied by an adult to enter pool area.
3. Proper swim attire is mandatory when entering pool. No cut off jean or colored cotton clothing. Fitted white t shirts are acceptable.
4. Children 3 and under or not potty trained must wear a swim diaper at all times.
5. At a quarter till each hour (0:45) there will be a 15 minute break signaled by one long whistle. All persons under the age of 18 must get out of the pool and splash pad area. Children 5 and under may swim or use the splash pad area at this time only if accompanied by an adult.
6. When thunder or lightning can be seen or heard, all persons must evacuate the pool and splash pad area. There is a mandatory 30 minute wait from the last observed thunder or lightning.
7. All injuries and incidents must be reported to the pool office and recorded.
8. No smoking, alcohol, or any form of illegal drugs are allowed in the pool area. Anyone under the influence will not be permitted to enter the pool premises.
9. If you have a membership, only the people on your pass can sign in using your number. You may not change the names on your membership card throughout the season.
10. No running, pushing, or rough play anywhere in the pool area.
11. No diving, spitting, dunking, pushing, or flips off the side of the pool.
12. No swimming with open or infected wounds.
13. Obey lifeguard instructions at all times and do not disrespect or distract lifeguards on duty.
14. No animals in pool area.
15. No foul language.
16. No gum, food, or drinks in the pool itself.
17. No walking along grating on the sides of the pool.
18. No hyperventilating before swimming underwater or breathe holding contests.
19. No glass containers allowed. Coolers and your own lawn chairs are permitted.
20. No intimate displays of affection.
21. Obey all posted slide and splash pad rules.
22. Children must be able to pass a swim test before using the big slide or swimming in the deep end. Swim test can be given during breaks by a lifeguard not on patron duty. Ask in office.
23. No goggles, boogie boards, or lifejackets on the slide.
24. When using either slide, exit immediately. Only go down slide feet first and on your bottom.
25. In case of early closings due to weather, vouchers will be issued to paying customers who had less than an hour to swim.
26. Manager on duty has final say.

Failure to comply with any of these rules may result in consequences ranging from sitting out on a designated bench to suspension from the pool. If problems persist, the pool manager reserves the right to expel the non-compliant patron from the pool for the remainder of the swimming season. McComb Pool is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please direct any questions or concerns to the pool manager. Thank you for you cooperation.
